Employees with many years of pedagogical experience, Candidate of Medical Sciences, Associate Professor, Honored Doctor of the Republic of Karakalpakstan Mambetov Zh.M., assistants Nurimbetov Kh.B., Kudaynazarova Z.B., Kosbatirova A.N., Turdimuratova K.U., Seytimbetova B.Z., Matkarimova A.A. contributed to the development of the department.

Having many years of pedagogical experience at the department, Doctor of Medical Sciences. Mambetkarimov G.A., Candidate of Medical Sciences, Associate Professor Matkarimova A.A., assistants Kudaynazarova Z.B., Kusbatirova A.N., Jalekeeva P.A., Seytimbetova B.Z., Matkarimova A.A., Utegenova S.T., Turdimuratova K.O., Elmuratova A.A., Bayniyazova B.M., Kurbanbaeva R.U., Jiemuratova G., Kalmuratova B.S., Kalenderova G.K., Utepbergenova G., Begjanova N.K. worked.



In the 1993-1994 academic year, the Department of "Pediatrics of Pediatric Disease Propedeutics," from the 1994-1995 academic year, the department was called the Department of "Hospital Pediatrics," the department was headed by Candidate of Medical Sciences, Associate Professor Zh.M. Mambetov.

In the 2009-2010 academic year, the Department of Faculty and Hospital Pediatrics was reorganized by merging it, headed by Associate Professor A.A. Matkarimova, Candidate of Medical Sciences. From the 2011-2012 academic year, the department was reorganized into the "Hospital Pediatrics" department, which was headed by the Doctor of Medical Sciences. Mambetkarimov G.A. Starting from the 2013-2014 academic year, 2 departments were reassigned to the Department of "BKP, Faculty and Hospital Pediatrics," and which was headed by the Doctor of Medical Sciences. Mambetkarimov G.A. From the 2015-2016 academic year, the position of Acting Head of the Department has been held. A.N. Kusbatirova.

From the 2017-2018 academic year to the 2021-2022 academic year, the department was headed by the Doctor of Medical Sciences. Mambetkarimov G.A.

From the 2022-2023 academic year, 2 departments were merged and the Department of Pediatrics, Obstetrics, Gynecology and Neonatology was reorganized, headed by Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor O.A. Ataniyazova. From the 2023-2024 academic year, 2 departments were merged and the Department of Pediatrics and Pediatric Surgery was reorganized, headed by Candidate of Medical Sciences R.R. Sabirov.

Starting from the 2024-2025 academic year, the department was reorganized and a separate "Pediatrics" department was created, headed by A.K. Omirova.

Currently, the Department of Pediatrics is located on the territory of the QTI, as well as on the clinical base of the Republican Children's Multidisciplinary Medical Center, where students study in the specialized departments of pulmonology, cardiology, nephrology, gastroenterology, allergology, hematology, OPN, functional, laboratory diagnostics, admission department, and consultative polyclinic. Currently, teachers A.N. Kusbatirova, A.A. Elmuratova, R.U. Kurbanbayeva with many years of pedagogical experience, and young assistants P. Turmanova, A.K. Tanirbergenova, D. Ibraimova, Kh. Askerbayeva, N. Saburova, G. Saparbayeva, N. Tursinbekova work at the department.

In 2003-2005, the department received a grant on GNTP on the topic: "Development of standards for diagnostics, rehabilitation, and prevention of iron deficiency in the rural children's population of the Republic of Karakalpakstan." Since 2011, the scientific problem of the department has been "Medical-Ecological Problem and Comprehensive Assessment of the Health Status of Children in the Aral Sea Region." Since 2024, the department has been conducting research on the topic "Development of methods for early diagnosis and treatment of congenital diseases in children in Karakalpakstan."
