Spiritual and educational work

Spiritual and educational activities are carried out in accordance with the official plan of the Department of Anatomy, Clinical Anatomy and Histology. Each holiday is celebrated in a lively and engaging manner, fostering students' sense of responsibility and love for their homeland.

Most of the activities are conducted with academic mentors in student groups, primarily involving 1st- and 2nd-year students of the faculties of Pediatrics, General Medicine, Preventive Medicine, and Dentistry.



The department's staff actively participates in all events organized both within the department and at the national and public level, together with their students.



They participated in the ethnographic and tourist center «Qaraqalpaq awılı» during the celebration of «Júweri gúrtik kúni».



Round table discussions with students are regularly held on various topics related to spiritual and educational matters, including the "Five Important Initiatives" proposed by the President of Uzbekistan, Shavkat Mirziyoyev.

2. The second initiative is to create conditions for the physical development of young people and to increase their engagement in sports.

5. The fifth initiative is to address the issues of employment opportunities for young women.
